The pale presence of primary health care in the villages if at all anything worth its name exists and the lack of access to tertiary health facilities makes it a truly need based activity

SPECTRUM OF MEDICAL SERVICES IN TELANGANA DURING -2021

Exclusive Medical camps for screening the patients for symptomatic and asymptomatic diseases. Specialty Medical camps offering Multi specialty Medicare such as Pediatrics, Medicine, dentistry, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Gynecology, ENT, Skin, General Surgery etc. Follow up services to provide for diagnostic, medical and surgical assistance for needy patients at reputed hospitals.

Due to Covid-19 pandemic, regular medical activities such as medical camps, eye camps, dental camps, clinics and single doctor clinics and Mobile Medical vans could not be conducted through out the year. However some of the Districts have come forward and conducted medical activities viz. general medical camps, eye camps etc. The details of medical camps conducted during 2021 are given below.

UTILITY AND IMPACT OF MEDICAL SERVICES IN 2021

MEDICAL CAMPS:



66 Medical camps conducted in the Districts of Mancheriyal, Nirmal, Kawrimnagar, Jagityal, Nagarkurnool, Wanaparthi, Warangal (U), Mahabubabad, Siddipeta, Sanga Reddy, Nizamabad, Nalgonda, Khammam, Bhadrachalam and Ranga Reddy districts. during the year 2021 benefitting 5632 patients. 175 doctors, 209 paramedical, 55 sevadal members participated in the medical seva.

BLOOD DONATION CAMPS

With the Divine Blessings of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba, young messengers of India have conducted Blood donation camps through out India in all States. The Blood donation camps were held purely motivated by the urge to help re-energise the blood banks and experience of beloved Bhagawan's message of "Manava Seva is Madhava Seva".



The young messengers of Telangana have motivated all youth in their districts for blood donation on 21.11.21. The District wise participation of blood donors details are as follows:

1.HYDERABAD DISTRICT:

New Eye camp Center at Gandhinagar, Hyderabad.



With the Blessings of Bhagawan Sri Sathya Sai Baba a new Eye camp center is opened at Gandhinagar on 18.8.21 by Sri R.J. Ratnakar, Managing Trustee, SSS Central Trust, Prasanthi Nilayam. The eye camps are being conducted every Saturday from 9-1 pm. Dr. K. Sandhya, Ophthalmologist is rendering medical seva every Saturday. Initially Balavikas students in all Samithis in Hyderabad District are being screened alongwith elders. So far 414 patients were screened in 18 camps, 29 Glasses prescribed. Two Squint cases, five Ratina, ten Glucoma cases, we cataract cases attended and referred to the higher hospitals

for further treatment. Gandhinagar Samithi given new glasses to 66 elder patients.

One Blood donation camp conducted at Shivam in Nov. 2021 . 65 members donated blood. 4 doctors, 6 paramedical and 15 sevadal members participated in the camp.

2. **Mancheriyal District:** Two health check up medical camps for pregnant ladies conducted benefitting 80 patients. One doctor, four paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated.

3. **Nirmal District:** One General Medical camp at Pasupula Kollam gudem conducted 265 patients. Three doctors, five paramedical 15 sevadal participated.

4. **Karimnagar District:** One General Medical camp at Kesaram conducted 200 patients. Six doctors, six paramedical 15 sevadal participated

5. **Jagityal District:-** One Dental camp conducted benefitting 70 patients. One doctor, One doctor, two paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated.

6. Nagar Kurnool:



Three general medical camps conducted at Chennaram village benefitting 542 tribal patients. Nine doctors, three paramedical and 30 sevadal members participated. Baby T. Harshitha (F/4), Avuloni Bai Thanda, undergone Cochlear Implantation surgery at Apollo Hospital, Jubilee Hills, Hyderabad on 28.10.21. 119 specs given. 92 patients identified for cataract surgeries. 268 patients undergone lab tests during the camps. 45 nearby tribal villages are being benefitted in this camp. This camp is being continued since last 90 months

at the same place.

7. **Wanaparthi District:** One General Medical camp at Chikkeyapalli conducted benefitting 212 patients. Six doctors, eight paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated.

8. **Warangal Urban District:** One eye camp conducted at Sriramulapalli village benefitting 102 patients. Three doctors, four paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated.

9. **Mahabubabad District:** One general medical camp conducted at Katrapalli (v) benefitting 191 patients. Four doctors, 5 paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated.

10. **Bhupalapalli District:** Under Sai Janani Tribal Development Project, two general medical camps conducted benefitting 146 patients. Three Doctors, two paramedical and 27 sevadal members participated.

11. **Siddipeta District:** Dr. I.S.Surendra, MS (Ortho) is conducting free medical camps for physically challenged patients every last Sunday since 2010 onwards. During 2021, twelve camps conducted benefitting 144 patients. One doctor, four paramedical and five sevadal members participated.

Besides above, one Dental camp was conducted at Anantaraopalli village benefitting 45 patients. One doctor, two paramedical and 5 sevadal members participated.

12. Sanga Reddy District:



One Cancer Awareness program conducted at Patancheru benefitting 56 patients. Four Doctors, six paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated. On 3.4.21 one Homeo camp conducted at Jogipeta, Sangareddy district, benefitting 104 patients. Three general medical camp conducted benefitting 316 patients. Ten doctors, 12 paramedical and 30 sevadal members participated.

13. **Nizamabad District:** One Dental camp at Jakrampalli village conducted benefitting 45 patients. One Doctor, two paramedical and five sevadal members participated.

One General at Dharpally for 65 RVTC members conducted. One doctor, two paramedical and five sevadal members participated.

14. **Nalgonda District:** One general medical camp conducted at Dokkala Bavi Thanda benefitting 96 patients. Four doctors, four paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated.

15. **Khammam District:** One eye camp at Madhira benefitting 32 patients conducted. One doctor, two paramedical and five sevadal members participated.

One Ayurveda camp at Mallaram village conducted benefitting 45 patients. One doctor, one paramedical and five sevadal members participated.

16. **Bhadrachalam District:** One General Medical camp conducted benefitting 159 patients. Two Doctors, 5 paramedical and 10 sevadal members participated. Sai Protein distributed to 250 patients.

There are 91 follow up services were provided during 2021. 111 patients undergone various surgeries, procedures investigations etc. were in the above hospitals.

COVID-19 – PROVIDING CONCENTRATED OXYGEN CONTAINERS

In view of the Covid-19 pandemic situation prevailing in India, All India President SSSSO have allotted 10 Concentrated Oxygen containers on 17.5.21 as first instalment and another 10 containers on 10.6.21. Sri Sathya Sai Trust, TS allotted 15 containers in first instalment on 29.5.21 and another 6 containers later.

With the Divine Blessings of Bhagawan Sri Sri Sri Sathya Sai Baba varu, Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Health Services project in Telangana has completed **ten** years of service to the poor and needy people.

These medical services include the Specialties viz. General Medicine, ENT, Ophthalmology, Dental medicine, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Orthopedics, Pediatrics and Dermatology. Details of Mobile Medical camps conducted in 2021 are given below:

Medchel District Mobile Medical Activity:



On 17.10.21 Medchel District conducted mega medical camp at Bachupalli benefitting 254 poor slum people. 50 spectacles distributed and four cataract surgeries identified. 60 patients treated in Dental Hospital Bus by two Dental Doctors. 215 Lab tests (viz. Blood sugar, CBP, Platelet count, Malaria Parasite, Myelofibrosis, ESR, AEC, Eosinophil test, Blood grouping, Blood Urea Serum Creatinine, Serum uric acid, Serum Bilirubin, R.A., Widal tests, Complete urine examination, T3, T4 and TSH, ECG) conducted. 10 Doctors and 22 paramedical

participated in the camp. In Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Dental Hospital, 60 Balavikas children screened. 20 Extractions, 20 GIC Restorations 20 scalings were done.

Sangareddy District Mobile Medical Activity:



On 24.10.21 Sangareddy district conducted mega medical camp at M.A. Nagar, Miyapur benefitting 318 patients. 35 spectacles and 17 cataract surgeries identified. 25 patients identified for further investigations and procedures at various higher medical institutions. 184 various Lab tests were conducted.

In Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Dental Hospital, 22 Balavikas children screened. 3 Extractions, 16 GIC Restorations done.

Ranga Reddy District Mobile Medical Activity:



On 31.10.21, Ranga Reddy district conducted mega medical camp Sri Sathya Sai Seva Sudha, Saroornagar benefitting 432 patients (202 male and 230 female). 120 Eye patients screened and identified for 30 cataract surgeries and 52 patients will be provided spectacles soon. Over 250 lab tests for various ailments done. 8 Doctors from General medicine, Cardiology, Orthopedic, Ophthalmology, Gynecology, Dental were rendered medical seva.

In Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Dental Hospital, 24 patients screened. 6 Extractions, 11 GIC Restorations, 6 scaling done.

Mobile Medical camps at Chennaram, Nagar Kurnool District:



Four Mobile Medical camps were conducted during 2021 benefitting 480 tribal patients from 45 tribal villages. 63 patients were provided with spectacles 56 patients identified for cataract surgeries. 87 patients undergone various blood tests in the camps. 12 Doctors participated in the divine medical seva.

Sai Janani (a Community Health care project in Tribal areas)

This project is being conducting at Thandra in Adilabad District , Asifabad, Bhadradi and Nagar Kurnool and Bhupalapalli Districts . So far 41 camps conducted benefitting 8895 tribal people.

Inauguration of Sai Janani Project in Mulugu District



On 26.9.21 Sai Janani Tribal development program is launched in Gundengi Vayi Thanda, Mulugu District. 92 patients treated. Four Doctors participated in the medical seva. Mosquito nets, Sarees, Blankets, Solar Lamps and Sai Protein for mal nutrition children have been given.

Sri H.J. Dora, Convenor, Sri Sathya Sai State Trust, Sri P. Venkata Rao, State President, Telangana, Sri A Malleswara Rao, District President, Hyderabad, Sri D. Kailash Prasad, Sri Sathya Sai State Trust, Sri Ramesh Sawanth, Member, National Council, SSSSO India and Dr P Gopi Krishna National Team Member and Dr J. Ramachandra Reddy and eminent doctors from Hyderabad were also present in the inauguration ceremony.

Advanced Equipment:

This Mobile Dental Hospital has advanced equipment to treat a variety of dental ailments.



Sri Sathya Sai Mobile Dental Hospital is equipped with two Dental chairs and inbuilt advanced accessories. B-class autoclave for High standard sterilization, high quality instruments, diagnostic equipment like handheld dental X-Ray, unit, with RGB for a spot diagnosis, LED unit for composite fillings, endo motor and accessory materials for root canal treatments, disposable tank for safe disposal of dental waste, air purifier for Microbial and viral free environment. There are two air compressors and external suction Motors. The bus runs on regular electricity, generator, and inverter backup. The bus is also equipped with a water purifier and Ozone system for sterile water. At any given time, the dentist can work comfortably in this complete air-conditioned bus.

SAI REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Sai Rehabilitation Program is a unique initiative of Baba's Super Specialty Hospitals in Puttaparthi and Whitefield, seeks to continue, sustain and boost the hospital-patient relationship. So far in Telangana State 368 patients (279 patients from Prasanthigram and 89 patients from Whitefield hospitals) received and attended. During 2021 three cases from Prasanthigram and four cases from Whitefield hospitals received and attended.

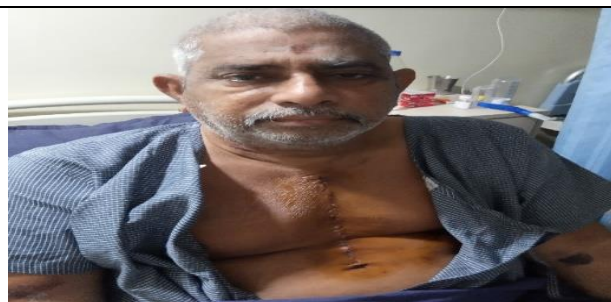

Amputation to his left leg done at KHIMS Hospital, Khammam in Feb. 2021. Since then he confined to bed and walking slowly with walker. Necessary reports have been obtained from the patient and sent to Dr. Narender, Bharat Vikas Parishad Charitable Trust, Kukkatpally and arranged artificial leg to the patient on 4.7.21.

Cancer follow up Cases

Patient Baby Gayatri,(F/13), d/o daughter of Sri Tirupathi Devapur (V) Peddapalli District is suffering from Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML) cancer of blood and admitted in MNJ Hospital, Hyderabad on 16.11.20 and started treatment. Four packet platelets and food for the attendants were provided. Patient discharged from hospital in February, 2021.

Vikarabad District - Telemedicine follow up case:

Smt. Chinta Anita, (F/35) Adikaqcherla (v), Vikarabad district approached telemedicine with a complaint of throat pain. Dr. K. Ram Babu, ENT surgeon seen the case and suggested Biopsy by Endoscopy at Post Cricoid area which reveals that she is having throat cancer. Patient has been taken to MNJ Hospital for further treatment. Radiation and Chemo started. Members of medical team are pursuing the case.

Neuro surgery follow up cases:

Yadadri District follow up case:

Patient K. Chandramouli (M/38) fallen from 1st floor on 14.7.21. On the advise of local doctors, patient has been taken to local hospital and symptomatic management and MRI whole spine, CT Brain, CT Chest was done. Foley's Catheterization done.

Patient had complete spinal cord injury from D8 level. Burst Compression Fracture, C3-C6 posterior elements fracture, Burst C5 fracture, scalp laceration , Right parietal subdural Hematoma, RIB fractures with Hem pneumothorax. Patient had fall from height at his native place with injuries on scalp left shoulder. Patient was initially treated and shifted to Continental Hospital for further treatment. Patient was taken up for emergency surgery after detailed counselling with the family members and poor prognosis is explained. Patient relatives were explained surgery is mainly for stabilization of Thoracic spine and to facilitate ambulation and chances of recovery in limbs were dismal. Dr. S. Laxminadh, MS (Neuro), did major surgery to thoracic spine done on 15.7.21. Patient condition was stable and discharged on 21.7.21.

On the advise of senior doctors and Dr. Laxminadh, patient shifted to Aakar Asha Hospital, for post operative care and physiotherapy on 21.7.21 evening in stable condition.

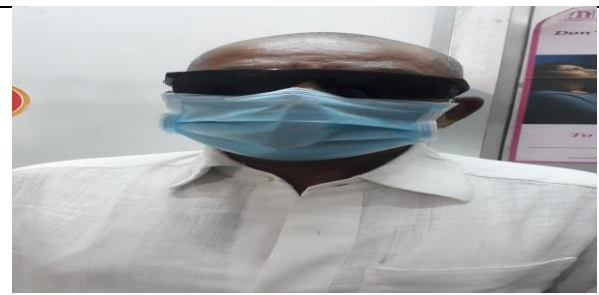

Veterinary Services in Telangana (Divine service to the silent creatures)
2021 (1.1.21 to 31.12.21)

SRI SATHYA SAI WELLNESS MISSION A HOLISTIC APPROACH

As a part of Holistic approach, the following steps will be taken up during 2022.

1. Health care Camps:

- To Improve the quality of care and bring about standardization across all health camps with the help of technology and digitization;
- Regular use of module for preventive health care. Every camp should have a counselling session on preventive care during their waiting period prior to seeing the doctor;
- Covid-19 Pandemic- Emphasis should be laid down on wearing masks, handwashing and strictly observing social distancy;
- Health care Sevalal – Develop well trained cadre for sevalal to render seva in Health camps and Mobile units. These sevalal should be trained on preventive health and handling emergencies as a first responder. Training module to be designed.
- The process of entertaining outdoor patients' registration, recording and follow up has been put on computer.

2. Mother and Child Care:

- Mother and child care should be one of the major focus areas for the next 5 years culminating in the centenary celebrations of our Swami.
- Care of ante natal women, lacting mothers and malnourished children upto the age of 14-15 years in SSSVIP villages, Bhajan Mandali villages, adopted villages and urban slums.

3. Sri Sathya Sai Rehabilitation Program:

- To be carried out in standard way across all the Districts.
- Have a standard training for all SRP Volunteers;
- Reach out to all cardiac patients operated during last 10 years.
- Ensure all Valve replacement patients are followed monthly PT/INR tests and **aim is zero mortality due to non compliance of the same.**

4. Divine Service for Silent Creatures:

- Increase Veterinary activity across all Districts.
- Involving more and more Veterinary doctors for helping in all activities;
- Involving the para Vety. Staff which is available in the rural levels in across the country

ACTION PLAN FOR CENTUNARY CELEBRATIONS (2022-25)

1. Preventive care is top most priority;
2. Mobile Health Services may be extended to neighboring districts;
3. Services of Mobile Dental Hospital may be given priority to Govt. Schools and Bal Vikas children.
4. Training to the volunteers on preventive care;
5. Telemedicine seva to be benefitted in rural/tribal areas;
6. Districts/Samithis having Mandirs, start medical clinics soon.
7. Each District may conduct atleast one major medical camp every year.
8. Hearing tests for new born children in all districts.
